# **Chilworth**Another rural station that is generally served every two hours, a short, steep walk from the beautiful St Martha's Hill and the North Downs Way. Chilworth Gunpowder Mill is also well worth a visit and a number of walks in the Tillingbourne Valley also begin here at Chilworth.

#### Shalford

A seven-platform station that is part of the international airport, providing fast trains to London and the South Coast via Southern Rail, Thameslink and Gatwick Express.

GWR operates an hourly service to Reading via Guildford.

Gatwick

The North Downs Line is operated by Great Western Railway and runs from Gatwick to Reading, this guide covers the Gatwick to Guildford stretch.

The Stations

There is a train every hour from this station, it's within easy reach of the North Downs Way via a path beside the River Wey. Why not visit East Shalford Mill (NT) or Chinthurst Tower. Both within a short walk of the station.

### Guildford

Opened a 'Platform 0' in early 2018 which allows for more through trains, there are two GWR services every hour leaving Redhill for Reading. It also serves London and the South Coast through Southern Rail and Thameslink.

A very busy station that is operated by Network Rail, providing fast trains to London and services to the south and south-west (via Woking or Reading). The Gatwick to Reading service calls twice per hour in each direction. Home to the Yvonne Arnaud Theatre, G-Live and Surrey University.
