The role: We are looking for someone to help us coordinate the project, doing things like organising volunteers, liaising with supporting groups and thinking of creative ways to adopt the station.

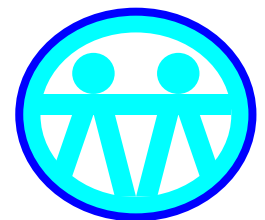


Hours: Whilst setting everything up, you will need to dedicate several hours a week to the project. Once established, perhaps just a couple of hours a week. Timings are flexible.
