On Saturday I will attend the open day at Reg's Garden. I can't wait to see the stationmaster's house and the latest improvements there.





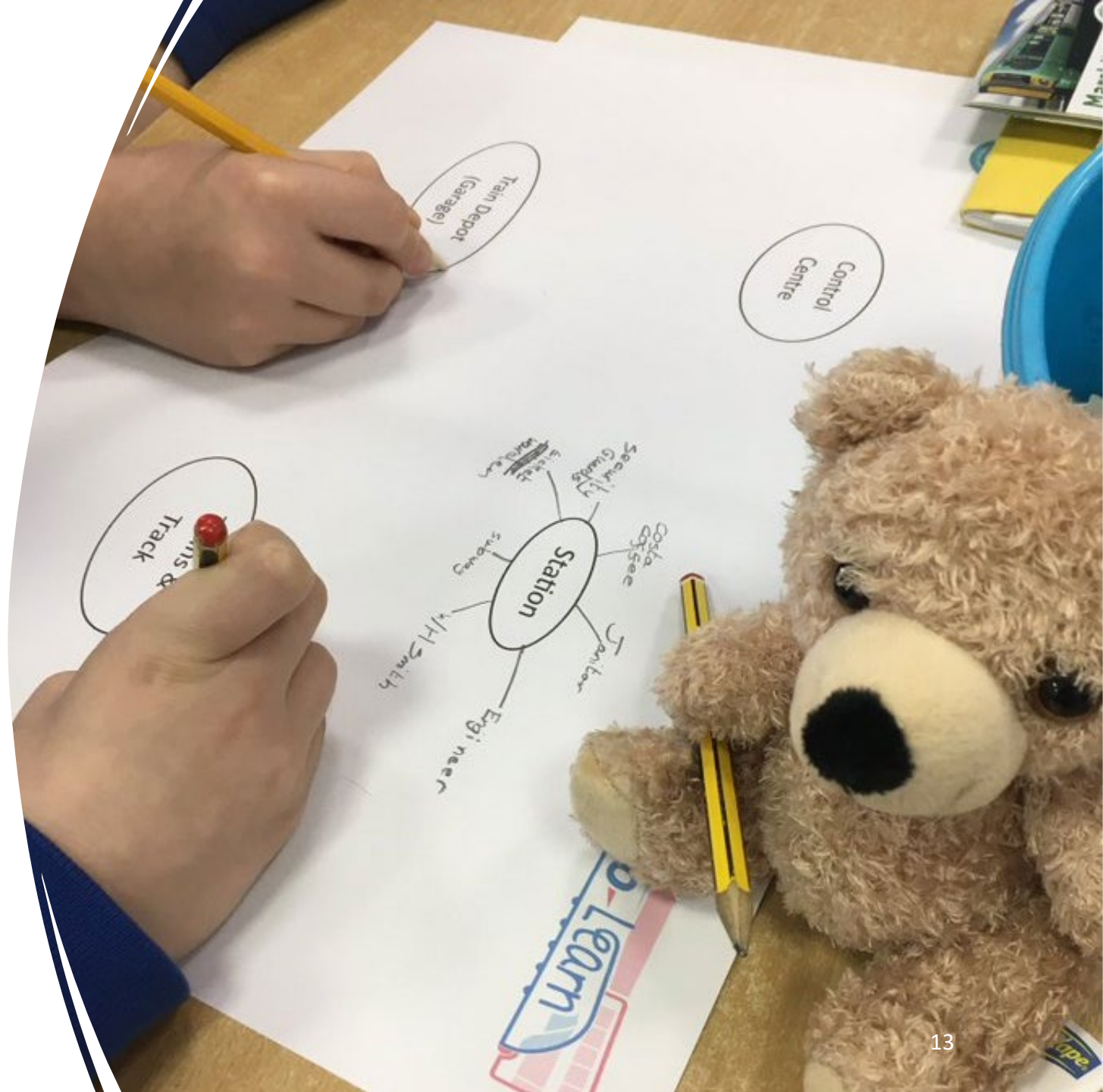
