# FELTHAM RAILWAY STATION

Feltham Railway Station was built in 1848. This timeline celebrates some things that have happened in Feltham's history.

1086

The Domesday book notes that there are 2 farms, 24 acreage, 100 oxen, 100 sheep, and 15-18 acres of land in Feltham.

1848

As Feltham station opens, Thomas Cook's office "The boys are killing all the hours of the day & some of the night, they are not only the best of the town's dancing."

1931

The first double-decker trolley buses designed and built in Feltham.

1932

The first Dorset, Dorset's first passenger trolley bus, built in Feltham. It was the first trolley bus in Dorset.

1939

William Butler Joyce's first novel opens a world of imagination and excitement. It was the first novel by Joyce to be published in Feltham. The book is called 'The Last Days of Pompeii'.

1944

The Feltham School Bus, designed by a local resident, was the first school bus in Feltham. It was built during the war.

1956

The first trolley bus developed and built in Feltham, designed by a local resident, was the first trolley bus in Feltham.

1966

The first trolley bus built in Feltham.

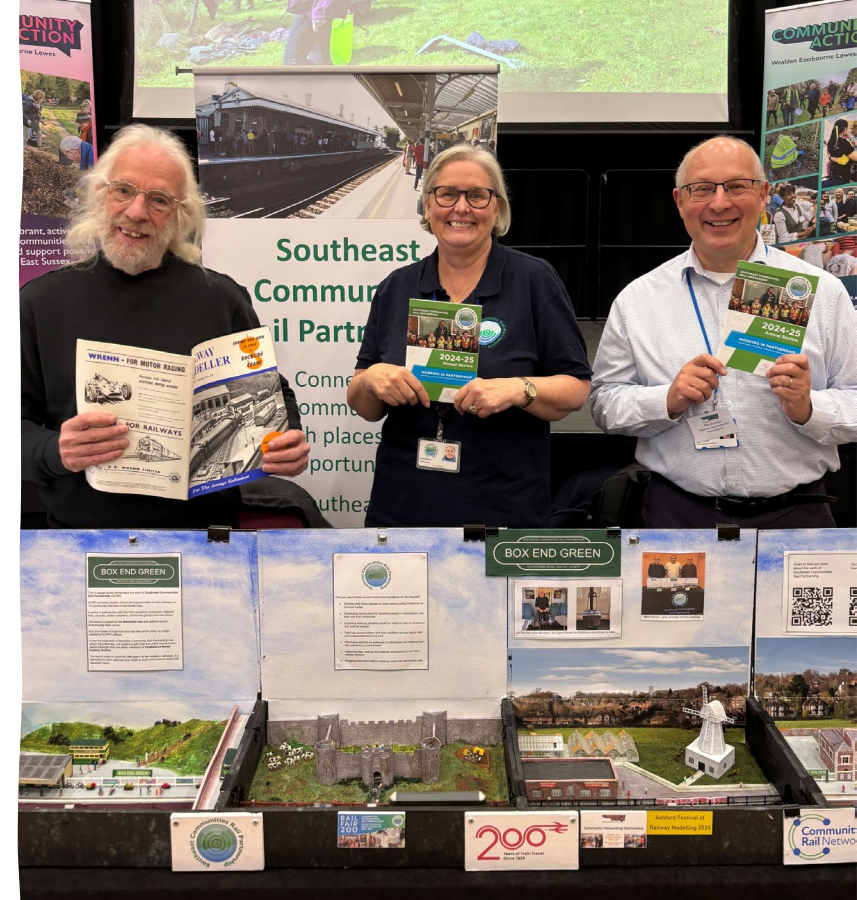

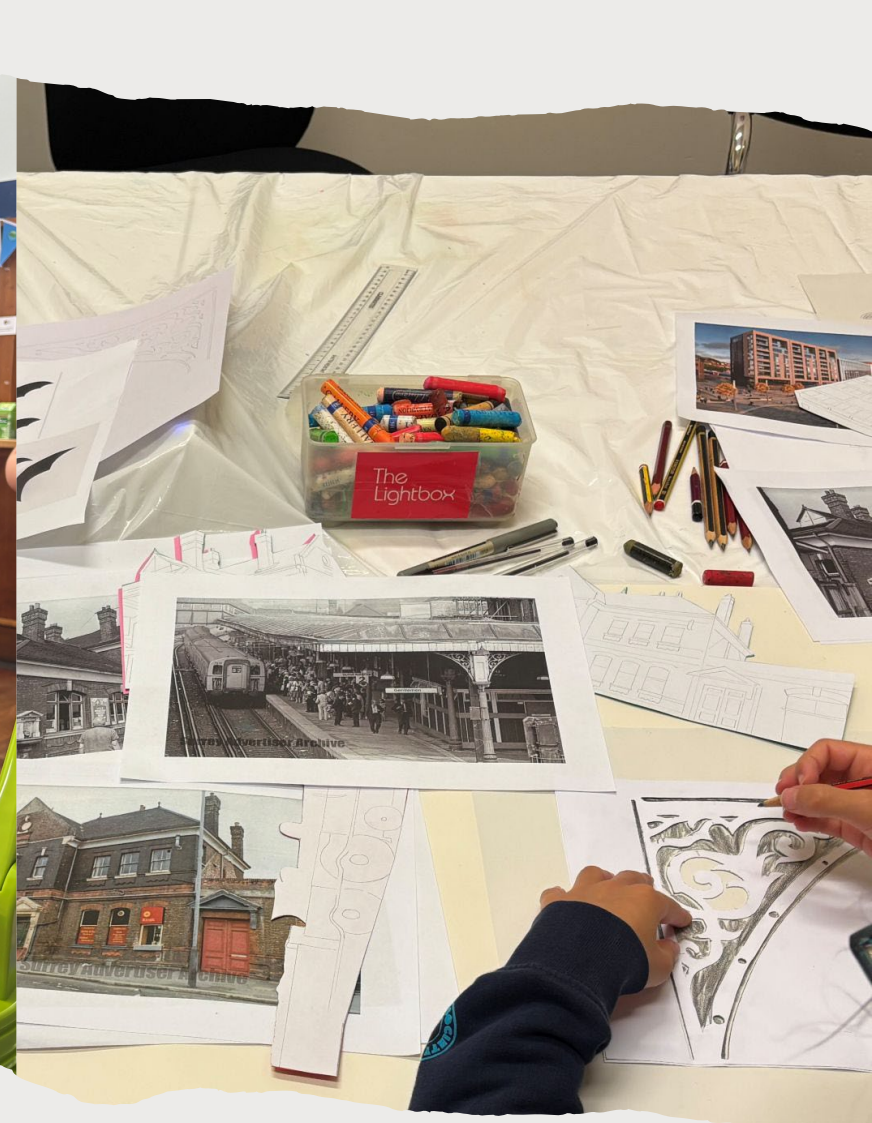

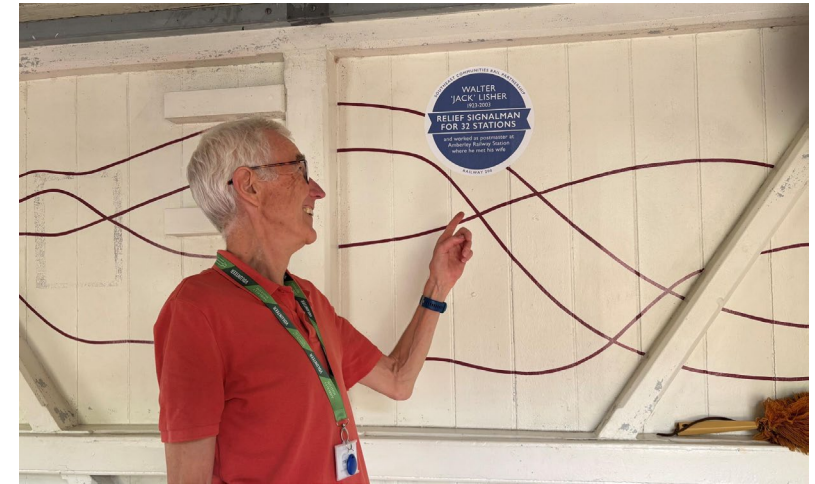
